





WHAT YARN WILL WE BE USING AND HOW MUCH WILL I NEED?

GLORIA is worked in Coop Knits Socks Yeah! 4ply

- **Meterage:** 212m/50g
- Composition: 75% Merino wool; 25% Nylon
- Washing Instructions: Machine wash 30°C

This is an estimate of what you'll need to make the standard one size capelet. I always advise waiting until a course starts before investing in your yarn. If you choose to make your capelet larger you may need to purchase an additional skein of YARN G.

'Flower' Colours YARN A: x 1 skein YARN B: x 1 skein YARN C: x 1 skein

YARN D: x 1 skein 'Background' Colours YARN E: x 1 skein

YARN F: x 1 skein YARN F: x 1 skein YARN G: Main Colour: x 3 skeins

I'm sorry but I won't be able to have individual conversations about your own colour choices until the course begins.

WHAT SIZE IS THE CAPELET?

Length: 32-34cm (It's designed to be slightly longer at the centre back) Neck: 50cm or 56cm (depending on preference) Width at hem: Approximately 180cm

You may omit one motif to achieve these measurements: Length: 32-34cm Neck: 47cm or 52.5cm (depending on preference) Width at hem: Approximately 170cm

You may add one motif to achieve these measurements: Length: 32-34cm Neck: 53cm or 59.5cm (depending on preference) Width at hem: Approximately 190cm

CAN I USE A DIFFERENT YARN?

Of course, you can work with whatever yarn you like but all my tensions and measurements will be based on the recommended yarn and whilst you could substitute a different 4ply yarn I can't provide any specific advice about measurement/tension/ yardage for alternative yarn choices.

WHAT HOOK SIZES WILL I NEED?

I'm using these hook sizes:

- 2.5mm
- 2.75mm
- 3.25mm

*You may need to use different sized hooks to achieve the same tension as me.

I AM TRYING TO BOOK MY PLACE ON YOUR WEBSITE, BUT IT WON'T ACCEPT MY POSTCODE?

WILL YOUR INSTRUCTIONS INCLUDE LEFT-HANDED INFORMATION, AMERICAN TERMINOLOGY AND BE WRITTEN IN DIFFERENT LANGUAGES?

I include left handed video tutorials and left handed stitch diagrams in all my course content.

My patterns will only be available in English, using UK crochet terminology.

WHAT OTHER MATERIALS OR EQUIPMENT WILL I NEED?

The following is a suggested list of useful materials and equipment:

• Tape measure, pins, iron, a suitable surface for blocking, bulldog clips or similar for weighting your work. (I like to weight my work before finishing to allow the fabric to 'drop'), large eyed wool needle (with a sharp point), small sharp scissors, stitch markers.

DO I NEED TO BE ON FACEBOOK TO CONNECT WITH OTHER PEOPLE ON THE COURSE?

No. The Zoom meetings are an opportunity for you to meet with other people on the course and you'll also have access to The Mercerie's private online **Crochet Community** where you can share pictures of your progress with others on the course and enjoy seeing finished products and work in progress by members of **Wallflowers** and **Homage to the (Granny) Square**
